BILL SUMMARY

- Designates a portion of U.S. Route 23, commencing at its intersection with Island Road and extending to its intersection with Little Walnut Road, within Pickaway County, as the "Army Specialist Gerald R. Jenkins Memorial Highway."¹
- Designates the portion of U.S. Route 62 within Pickaway County as the "Army PFC Kevin C. Ott Memorial Highway."²
- Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highways.³

COMMENT

Army Specialist Gerald R. Jenkins died on October 20, 2010, in Maquan, Zhari district, Afghanistan while serving in Operation Enduring Freedom.

Army PFC Kevin C. Ott was killed in action in Iraq in June 2003 while serving in Operation Iraqi Freedom.
