CONTENT AND OPERATION

University of Notre Dame license plate

The bill creates the following license plate (R.C. 4503.514):

Special License Plate	University of Notre Dame license plate, inscribed with the words and markings selected by the University of Notre Dame.
Recipients	Available to all applicants.
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, motorcycle, cab-enclosed motorcycle, commercial motor vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, and, effective January 1, 2017, any motor-driven cycle or motor scooter.
Contribution and Additional BMV Fee	\$30 required contribution. \$10 additional administrative BMV fee.
Use of Contribution	Contributions must be used by the University of Notre Dame (South Bend, Indiana) to award grants or scholarships to residents of Ohio who attend the University. The University may use not more than 20% of the contributions for purposes of administering the scholarship program. (<i>R.C. 4501.21</i>). The Registrar must enter into appropriate agreements with the University to effectuate the distribution of the
	contributions.
Requirements for Issuance	(1) Submission of an application;
	(2) Payment of the regular license tax, contribution, administrative fee, any applicable local tax, any applicable

	special reserved license plate fee; and
	(3) Compliance with all other applicable laws relating to motor vehicle registration.
Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates apply.
