CONTENT AND OPERATION

"Ohio Nurses Association" license plate

The bill creates the following license plate:1

Special License Plate	Ohio Nurses Association license plate, inscribed with identifying words or markings selected by the Ohio Nurses Association and approved by the Registrar.
Recipients	Available to all applicants.
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles.
Contribution and Additional BMV Fee	\$25 required contribution for registration; \$11.50 for registration renewal.\$10 additional administrative BMV fee.
Use of Contribution	Contributions must be used by the Ohio Nurses Foundation to provide educational scholarships to assist individuals who aspire to join the nursing profession, to assist nurses in the nursing profession who seek to advance their education, and to support persons conducting nursing research concerning the evidence-based practice of nursing and the improvement of patient outcomes. ²
Requirements for Issuance	 (1) Submission of an application; (2) Payment of the regular license tax, contribution, administrative fee, any applicable local tax, any applicable special reserved license plate fee; and

	(3) Compliance with all other applicable laws relating to motor vehicle registration.
Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates apply. ³
