CONTENT AND OPERATION

"Ohio Association of Child Caring Agencies" license plate

The bill creates the following license plate:1

Special License Plate	Ohio Association of Child Caring Agencies license plate, which bears words and markings selected by the Ohio Association of Child Caring Agencies approved by the Registrar.
Recipients	Available to all applicants.
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, motorcycle, cab-enclosed motorcycle, commercial motor vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. Effective January 1, 2017, any motor-driven cycle or motor scooter.
Contribution and Additional BMV Fee	\$25 required contribution.\$10 additional administrative BMV fee.
Use of Contribution	Contributions must be used by the Ohio Association of Child Caring Agencies to pay the expenses it incurs in advancing its mission of sustainably improving the provision of services to children, young adults, and families in Ohio. ²
Requirements for Issuance	(1) Submission of an application;

	 (2) Payment of the regular license tax, contribution, administrative fee, any applicable local tax, any applicable special reserved license plate fee; and (3) Compliance with all other applicable laws relating to motor vehicle registration.
Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates apply. ³
