CONTENT AND OPERATION

"I Stand with Israel" license plate

The bill creates the following license plate:¹

Special License Plate	I Stand with Israel license plate, which bears words and markings selected by the Friends of United Hatzalah of Israel and approved by the Registrar.
Recipients	Available to all applicants.
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles.
Contribution and Additional BMV Fee	\$20 required contribution.\$10 additional administrative BMV fee.
Use of Contribution	Contributions must be used by the Friends of United Hatzalah of Israel to support United Hatzalah of Israel, which provides free emergency medical first response throughout Israel. ²
Requirements for Issuance	 (1) Submission of an application; (2) Payment of the regular license tax, any applicable local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any applicable special reserved license plate fee; and (3) Compliance with all other applicable laws relating to

	motor vehicle registration.
Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates apply. ³
