The bill designates the following roadway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the roadway:

Designated Name	Roadway
The "196th Light Infantry Brigade SP4 Robert L. Fowble Jr and PFC Jack E. Beam Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>	State Route 571, commencing at the southeastern boundary of Union City and proceeding in a southeasterly direction to the western boundary of Greenville, in Darke County only.
