#### **BILL SUMMARY**

• Increases from \$3,000 to \$6,000 the monetary jurisdiction of a small claims division of a county and municipal court.

#### CONTENT AND OPERATION

### Monetary limit on jurisdiction of small claims division

The bill increases, from \$3,000 to \$6,000, the monetary jurisdiction of a small claims division of a county and municipal court. Under continuing law, each county and municipal court is required to establish a small claims division.<sup>1</sup> A small claims division has jurisdiction in civil actions for the recovery of taxes and money only, for amounts not exceeding \$3,000, not including interest and cost. The bill increases this monetary jurisdiction amount to \$6,000.<sup>2</sup>
