BILL SUMMARY

The bill designates the following roadway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the roadway:

Designated Name	Roadway
The "SPC James E. Hall, Jr. Memorial Highway" ¹	The portion of S.R. 73 commencing at the intersection of that route and Jacksonburg Road and proceeding in an easterly direction to the intersection of S.R. 73 and Wehr Road within Butler County.
