131st General Assembly (H. Transportation & Infrastructure)

Designates the Lt. Col. Ralph D. Cole Memorial Bridge.

Designates *both* the eastbound and westbound bridges that will span the Cuyahoga River in Cuyahoga County as part of I-90 as the George V. Voinovich Bridge rather than only *the* bridge that will span the Cuyahoga River as in current law.
