## BILL SUMMARY

• Designates February 3 as "Charles Follis Day" in honor of the first African American professional football player.

### CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates February 3 as "Charles Follis Day" in honor of the first African American professional football player, who was born on that day in 1879.<sup>1</sup> Mr. Follis was the starting halfback for the Shelby Blues, a team in Shelby, Ohio, first playing for the team in 1902.<sup>2</sup>
