CONTENT AND OPERATION

The Improved Benevolent and Protective Order of the Elks of the World (IBPOEW) license plate

The bill creates the following license plate:1

Special License Plate	The Improved Benevolent and Protective Order of the Elks of the World (IBPOEW) license plate, which bears the acronym "IBPOEW" and a marking designed by the Ohio Association of the Improved Benevolent and Protective Order of the Elks of the World that is approved by the Registrar.
Recipients	Available to all applicants.
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles.
Contribution and Additional BMV Fee	\$25 required contribution. \$10 additional administrative BMV fee.
Use of Contribution	Contributions must be used by the Ohio Association of the Improved Benevolent and Protective Order of the Elks of the World for charitable purposes. ²
Requirements for Issuance	(1) Submission of an application;(2) Payment of the regular license tax, contribution, administrative fee, any applicable local tax, any applicable special reserved license plate fee; and

	(3) Compliance with all other applicable laws relating to motor vehicle registration.
Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates apply. ³
