BILL SUMMARY

• Revises the continuing education requirements for architects and landscape architects.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Continuing education requirements for architects and landscape architects

Under continuing law, the Architects Board may adopt rules pertaining to the satisfactory completion of continuing education requirements for architects.¹ The Ohio Landscape Architects Board may do the same for landscape architects.² The bill modifies continuing education requirements for architects and landscape architects by eliminating the requirement for both Boards, if either adopts rules pertaining to continuing education requirements, to specify in the rules that the continuing education requirements may be satisfied by coursework or activities dealing with technical, ethical, or managerial topics relevant to the practice of architecture or landscape architecture, as appropriate, and that a registrant may earn continuing professional education hours by completing or teaching university or college level coursework; attending seminars, workshops, or conferences; authoring relevant published papers, articles, or books; receiving patent awards; actively participating in professional or technical societies serving the profession, or actively participating in any other activity

deemed relevant by the Board. Thus, neither Board is required to specify these matters in its rules, if it adopts rules pertaining to continuing education requirements.

Current law requires the Boards' rules related to continuing education requirements, if any, to include these matters.

Law not changed by the bill continues to require that the Board, in general, follow model continuing education recommendations if the Architects Board or the Ohio Landscape Architects Board adopts rules pertaining to continuing education requirements. For the Architects Board, the recommendations are those established by the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards or a similar successor organization.³ For the Ohio Landscape Architects Board, the recommendations are those established by the Council of Landscape Architectural Registration Boards or a similar successor organization.4
