BILL SUMMARY

• Designates February 3 as "Charles Follis Day" in honor of the first African American professional football player.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates February 3 as "Charles Follis Day" in honor of the first African American professional football player, who was born on that day in 1879. Mr. Follis was the starting halfback for the Shelby Blues, a team in Shelby, Ohio, and first played for the team in 1902.
