Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments*

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Sub. H.B. 207 131st General Assembly (S. Insurance)

Creates a deadline of 180 days after the Administrator of Workers' Compensation receives a request under the bill to charge a claim potentially meeting the bill's requirements to the Surplus Fund Account in the State Insurance Fund for the Administrator to determine whether the claim is to be charged to that Account.

Requires the Administrator, if the Administrator does not make the determination within the required timeframe, to charge the claim to the Surplus Fund Account pursuant to the bill.

Eliminates a current law requirement that the Administrator consider whether an employer has at least 500 employees in determining whether to grant self-insuring status to the employer under the Workers' Compensation Law.
