Sub. Bill Comparative Synopsis

(H. Education)

This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Topic	H.B. 264 (As Introduced)	Sub. H.B. 264 (LSC 131 0145-6)
Distribution of policy	<p>Requires each state institution of higher education to annually provide a copy of the institution's policy on dating violence, domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, and rape to each student enrolled in that institution (<i>R.C. 3345.43(B)(1)</i>).</p> <p>Requires each state institution, not later than one year after the bill's effective date, to annually include a copy of the policy in the packet of documents that students are required to sign upon enrollment or during student orientation (<i>R.C. 3345.43(B)(1)</i>).</p> <p>Requires each state institution to post copies of the policy in multiple, prominent locations across campus (<i>R.C. 3345.43(C)</i>).</p>	<p>No provision.</p> <p>Similar, but (1) requires each state institution to annually distribute copies of the policy during student orientation and "at other appropriate events" and (2) does not specify a date by which state institutions must comply with this requirement (<i>R.C. 3345.43(B)</i>).</p> <p>Same, but also requires each state institution to post a copy in a prominent location on the institution's website (<i>R.C. 3345.43(B)</i>).</p>

Topic	H.B. 264 (As Introduced)	Sub. H.B. 264 (LSC 131 0145-6)
Acknowledgement of receipt of policy	Requires that either: (1) Each student sign an acknowledgment of receipt of a copy of the policy; or (2) The president of the state institution, or the president's designee, sign a statement, to be filed with the registrar's office, confirming that all students received a copy of the policy (<i>R.C. 3345.43(B)(2)</i>).	No provision.
