ACT SUMMARY

• Authorizes a subdivision to impose a 9-1-1 system levy in only the portion of the subdivision that would be served by the 9-1-1 system.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The act authorizes a subdivision to levy a tax for the establishment and operation of a 9-1-1 system in only the portion of the subdivision that would be served by the system. As part of the authorization, the act permits the renewal of a 9-1-1 system tax levy that was imposed in all of a subdivision's territory to be imposed only in areas receiving or to receive the 9-1-1 system service. Only electors residing in the portion of the subdivision subject to the tax would be permitted to vote on the question of the levy.¹
