BILL SUMMARY

- Authorizes the owner of a motor vehicle, when a certificate of title is issued for the vehicle, to request that the certificate indicate that the vehicle is a replica vehicle.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Replica motor vehicle designation on certificate of title

The bill authorizes the owner of a motor vehicle to request, at the time a common pleas court clerk issues a physical or electronic certificate of title, duplicate certificate of title, or memorandum certificate of title for the motor vehicle, that the vehicle's certificate of title indicate that it is a replica motor vehicle. The bill requires the Registrar of Motor Vehicles to designate the words, or marking or symbol, necessary to indicate that a motor vehicle is a replica motor vehicle.¹

Effective date

The bill has a delayed effective date. The bill's changes take effect 180 days after the bill is enacted.²
