## **CONTENT AND OPERATION**

### **"Conquer Childhood Cancer" license plate**

The bill creates the following license plate:<sup>1</sup>

<b>Special License Plate</b>	<b>Conquer Childhood Cancer</b> license plate, which is inscribed with identifying words and markings that are designed by the St. Baldrick's Foundation and approved by the Registrar.
<b>Recipients</b>	Available to all applicants.
<b>Eligible Vehicles</b>	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles.
<b>Contribution and Additional BMV Fee</b>	\$25 required contribution.  \$10 additional administrative BMV fee.
<b>Use of Contribution</b>	Contributions must be used by the St. Baldrick's Foundation for its research and other programs. <sup>2</sup>
<b>Requirements for Issuance</b>	(1) Submission of an application;  (2) Payment of the regular license tax, any applicable local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any applicable special reserved license plate fee; and  (3) Compliance with all other applicable laws relating to motor vehicle registration.

<b>Combined with Special Reserved License Plate</b>	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
<b>Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures</b>	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates apply. <sup>3</sup>
