## CONTENT AND OPERATION

### "Ohio Pupil Transportation...Safety First!!!" license plate

The bill creates the following license plate:<sup>1</sup>

<b>Special License Plate</b>	<b>Ohio Pupil Transportation...Safety First!!!</b> license plate, which is inscribed with the words "Ohio Pupil Transportation...Safety First!!!" and a design, logo, or marking selected and designed by the Ohio Association for Pupil Transportation and that is approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles.
<b>Recipients</b>	Available to all applicants.
<b>Eligible Vehicles</b>	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles.
<b>Contribution and Additional BMV Fee</b>	\$10 required contribution.  \$10 additional administrative BMV fee.
<b>Use of Contribution</b>	Contributions must be used by the Ohio Association for Pupil Transportation to support transportation programs, provide training to school transportation professionals, and support other initiatives for school transportation safety. <sup>2</sup>
<b>Requirements for Issuance</b>	(1) Submission of an application;  (2) Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and

	(3) Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.
<b>Combined with Special Reserved License Plate</b>	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
<b>Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures</b>	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates do not apply. <sup>3</sup>
