CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Hilliard Patrol Officer Sean Johnson Memorial Highway" ¹	The portion of Interstate Route 270 located in Franklin County, commencing at the interchange of Interstate Route 270 and State Route 161 and extending in a westerly direction to the intersection of Interstate Route 270 and Cemetery Road
