### **CONTENT AND OPERATION**

The bill designates the following highways and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highways indicating their names:

Designated Name	Highway
"Sergeant Sylvester Antolak Medal of Honor Recipient Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>	The portion of Interstate Route 70, located in Belmont County, commencing at mile marker 220.3 and proceeding in an easterly direction to mile marker 221.3
"Sergeant Emile DeLeau, Jr. Medal of Honor Recipient Memorial Highway" <sup>2</sup>	The portion of Interstate Route 70, located in Belmont County, commencing at mile marker 216.8 and proceeding in an easterly direction to mile marker 217.8

#### COMMENT

Sergeant Sylvester Antolak was killed in action on May 24, 1944 in Cisterna di Littoria, Italy during World War II. Sergeant Emile DeLeau, Jr. was killed in action on February 2, 1945 in Oberhoffen, France during World War II. Both soldiers posthumously received the Medal of Honor for their bravery and leadership in their final battles.
