• Designates the period of each year beginning March 13 and ending April 15 as "Ohio Deaf History Month."

Ohio Deaf History Month

The bill designates the period of each year beginning March 13 and ending April 15 as "Ohio Deaf History Month."¹ Congress designated this same period as "National Deaf History Month" for the purpose of celebrating deaf history and promoting awareness of American deaf culture.²
