BILL SUMMARY

- Permits a board of alcohol, drug addiction, and mental health services to authorize its executive director to execute contracts valued at \$50,000 or less without the board's prior approval.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

ADAMHS board contracts

Under continuing law, the executive director of a board of alcohol, drug addiction, and mental health services (ADAMHS board) is authorized to execute contracts on the board's behalf. Current law requires prior approval from the board for each contract.¹ The bill permits an ADAMHS board to establish a rule, operating procedure, standard, or bylaw allowing its executive director to execute contracts valued at \$50,000 or less, as determined by the board, on the board's behalf without the board's prior approval.²
