CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Army Corporal Carl H. Bernhart Memorial Highway" ¹	The portion of State Route 43 commencing at mile marker 12 and proceeding in a northwesterly direction to mile marker 14, in Jefferson County
