Sub. Bill Comparative Synopsis

132nd General Assembly (H. Community and Family Advancement)

This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Topic	Previous Version (As Introduced)	Sub. Version (L-132-0605-6)
License plate numbers included on verification form	Requires the verification form to include the license plate numbers of all vehicles owned or operated by the person diagnosed with a communication disability or registered in that person's name (R.C. 3304.23(C)(5)).	Same, but requires the verification form to also include the license plate numbers of vehicles regularly occupied by the person diagnosed with a communication disability (R.C. 5502.08(C)(5)).
Any other information included on verification form	Requires the verification form to include any other information the Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities Agency may require (R.C. 3304.23(C)(9)).	No provision.
Electronic availability of the verification form	No provision.	Requires the Department of Public Safety and the Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities Agency to make the verification form electronically available on their respective websites (R.C. 3304.23(E)).

Topic	Previous Version (As Introduced)	Sub. Version (L-132-0605-6)
Information required to be included in the database	Requires the Department of Public Safety to include in the database all the information provided on the verification form submitted by the person diagnosed with a communication disability or the person's parent or guardian (R.C. 5502.08(E)(1)).	Requires the Department of Public Safety to include in the database information provided on a completed verification form that the Department determines is necessary for a law enforcement officer to identify a person as diagnosed with a communication disability (R.C. 5502.08(E)(1)).

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
