## Fiscal Note & Local Impact Statement

**Bill:** H.B. 139 of the 132nd G.A.

**Status:** As Introduced

**Sponsor:** Reps. Perales and Keller

**Local Impact Statement Procedure Required:** No

**Subject:** Eliminates the public disclosure exemption for permanently retained records after the 100-year mark

---

Public offices could incur some negligible costs to prepare and make available the additional records that would otherwise be exempt from disclosure under the Public Records Act. The bill specifies that a record that is not a public record because it is exempted by the Public Records Act, and that, under law, is permanently retained, becomes a public record on the day that is 100 years after the day on which the record was created, except for any record protected by the attorney-client privilege, or a "trial preparation record."
