## CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Army Specialist David Lee Bingamon Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>	The northbound and southbound lanes of U.S. Route 68 between the intersection of that route and Waits Road and the intersection of that route and Clements Road, in Brown County.

Army Specialist David Lee Bingamon died on July 11, 1968, while serving during the Vietnam Conflict.
