# H.B. 300 132nd General Assembly (As Introduced)

### **BILL SUMMARY**

Requires the Registrar of Motor Vehicles to issue a nondriver identification card that does not have an expiration date to an Ohio resident who is permanently disabled.

### CONTENT AND OPERATION

### Nondriver identification cards

### **Background**

Under current law, any resident or temporary resident of Ohio who does not hold a driver's license issued by any state may apply for an identification card issued by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles or a deputy registrar. Such an identification card is provided for the purpose of establishing the identity of the bearer, and includes a color photograph and information similar to that found on a driver's license.<sup>2</sup> An identification card expires on the birthday of the cardholder in the fourth year after the date on which it is issued.3

## Expiration date for a resident who is permanently disabled

The bill requires the Registrar of Motor Vehicles to issue a nondriver identification card without an expiration date (see **COMMENT**) to an Ohio resident who is permanently disabled. For purposes of issuing the identification cards, an Ohio

resident who is permanently disabled has a condition of disability from which there is no present indication of recovery. The bill requires the Registrar to adopt rules governing the documentation a cardholder must submit in order to certify that the cardholder is permanently disabled.<sup>4</sup>

#### COMMENT

R.C. 3501.01(AA)(4) defines "photo identification" for purposes of the Elections Law. Under that division, a photo identification document is required to include an expiration date that has not passed. In light of this requirement, it appears that a nondriver identification card issued without an expiration date in accordance with the bill could not be used for voting purposes.
