## CONTENT AND OPERATION

### "Lions Club" license plate

The bill creates the following license plate:<sup>1</sup>

<b>Special License Plate</b>	<b>Lions Club</b> license plate, which is inscribed with identifying words or markings that are selected by the Ohio Lions Foundation and that are approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles.
<b>Recipients</b>	Available to all applicants.
<b>Eligible Vehicles</b>	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.
<b>Contribution, Additional BMV Fee, and Use of Contribution</b>	\$15 contribution directed to the Ohio Lions Foundation to be used for charitable and educational purposes. <sup>2</sup>  \$10 additional administrative BMV fee.
<b>Requirements for Issuance</b>	(1) Submission of an application;  (2) Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and  (3) Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.

<b>Combined with Special Reserved License Plate</b>	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
<b>Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures</b>	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates apply. <sup>3</sup>
