Subject: In-Demand Jobs Week

Beginning in 2018, the bill designates the full week beginning on the first Monday in May as "In-Demand Jobs Week" and, every year during this week, requires the Governor's Office of Workforce Transformation (OWT), in collaboration with the Department of Job and Family Services, the Ohio Department of Education, and the Department of Higher Education, to organize activities to raise awareness of jobs that are in demand by Ohio employers and the requirements and benefits of those jobs. These activities must include job fairs and company tours that connect middle and high school students with local employers. Any fiscal effect associated with this provision is minimal, at most. OWT indicated that existing staff will organize In-Demand Jobs Week activities.
