#### CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Captain Michael Palumbo Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>	The northbound and southbound lanes of Interstate Route (IR) 271 from mile marker 28 to mile marker 32, in Cuyahoga County.

#### **COMMENT**

Beachwood Fire Captain Michael Palumbo died on May 24, 2017 after a long battle with occupational brain cancer. The Michael Louis Palumbo, Jr. Act (Sub. S.B. 27), which allows firefighters who qualify as disabled by cancer the opportunity to file a claim with the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation, was enacted in the 131st General Assembly and became effective April 6, 2017.
