CONTENT AND OPERATION

"Pelotonia" license plate

The bill creates the following license plate:¹

| Special License Plate | Pelotonia license plate, inscribed with identifying words and markings that are designed by representatives of Pelotonia and that are approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. | |

| Recipients | Available to all applicants. | |
| Eligible Vehicles | Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar. | |
| Contribution and Additional BMV Fee | \$15 required contribution.\$10 additional administrative BMV fee. | |
| Use of Contribution | Contributions must be used by Pelotonia for the purpose of supporting cancer research. ² | |
| Requirements for Issuance | (1) Submission of an application; (2) Payment of the regular license tax, contribution, administrative fee, any applicable local tax, any applicable special reserved license plate fee; and | |
