This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Ohio Consumer Sales Practices Act (CSPA)	No provision.	Establishes that a violation of the bill's prohibition against a pyramid promotional scheme is considered an <i>unfair or deceptive act or practice</i> <i>in connection with a consumer transaction</i> , which is a violation of the CSPA (<i>R.C. 1333.92 and</i> <i>1333.94 and R.C. 1345.02, not in the bill</i>).
	No provision.	Permits the Attorney General to use all the powers and remedies existing under the CSPA to enforce violations of the prohibition against pyramid promotional schemes (<i>R.C. 1333.94 and R.C. 1345.01 to 1345.13, not in the bill</i>).

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
