CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highways and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along each highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Arnold R. Pinkney Memorial Way" ¹	The eastbound and westbound lanes of U.S. Route 422, between the intersection of that route with Woodland Avenue and East 55th Street and the intersection of that route with the western boundary of the municipal corporation of Shaker Heights, in the municipal corporation of Cleveland only; and The eastbound and westbound lanes of U.S. Route 422, between the intersection of that route and North Lane Avenue and the intersection of that route and S.R. 616, in the municipal corporation of Youngstown only.

Arnold R. Pinkney was a Cleveland businessman, civil rights activist, and political consultant.
