ACT SUMMARY

- Designates the full week beginning on the first Monday in May as "In-Demand Jobs Week."
- Requires the Governor's Office of Workforce Transformation, in collaboration with other agencies, to organize activities annually during that week for educators, students, and parents with respect to Ohio's in-demand jobs.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Beginning in 2018, the act designates the full week beginning on the first Monday in May as "In-Demand Jobs Week." Every year during In-Demand Jobs Week, the Governor's Office of Workforce Transformation, in collaboration with the Departments of Job and Family Services, Education, and Higher Education, must organize activities to raise awareness among educators, students, and parents of jobs that are in demand by Ohio employers and their requirements and benefits. The activities must include job fairs and company tours to connect middle- and high-school students with employers.¹
