CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Michael J. Aselage Memorial Highway" ¹	A portion of State Route 705, commencing at the intersection with Sawmill Road and proceeding in a southerly and easterly direction to the intersection with Eilerman Road, in Shelby County.

COMMENT

Michael J. Aselage was the first line of duty death for the Fort Loramie Community Fire Company. He died in 1975 while attempting to direct cars around a downed live electrical wire on State Route 705.
