Subject: Designates the Lance Corporal Christopher J. Dyer USMC, Lima Co, 3/25 Marines Memorial Highway

As a result of the bill, the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) will incur a minimal cost for producing and installing memorial signs. The bill designates a span of Interstate Route 75 within Hamilton County as the Lance Corporal Christopher J. Dyer USMC, Lima Co, 3/25 Marines Memorial Highway. Specifically, the designation applies to the roadway along Interstate Route 75 between mile marker 13 and mile marker 15.

If a memorial highway is designated on an interstate route, ODOT produces and installs the signs. According to ODOT, the cost of producing and installing a set of signs for memorial highways and bridges is approximately \$350 to \$400, including materials and labor. Two markers are usually installed, one in each direction at each location. Once a set of signs is installed, there are typically no maintenance costs unless the signs are damaged. Signs usually need to be replaced every 12 to 15 years.
