## CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Roy Rogers Happy Trails Highway" <sup>1</sup>	The portion of the road known as State Route (SR) 348, running in an easterly and westerly direction, between the intersections of that route with SR 104 and SR 73, in Scioto County
