#### **CONTENT AND OPERATION**

The bill designates the following highways and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highways indicating their names:

Designated Name	Highway
"Patrolman Charles K. Yates Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>	The eastbound and westbound lanes of U.S. Route 224 between the intersections of Diana Drive and the Pennsylvania border, in Mahoning County.
"Patrolman Richard E. Becker Memorial Highway" <sup>2</sup>	The portion of State Route 170, running in a northwesterly and southeasterly direction between the southeastern border of the municipal corporation of Poland and the northwestern border of Springfield Township, in Mahoning County.

#### COMMENT

Patrolman Charles K. Yates died on March 30, 1984 from a fatal heart attack following repeated struggles with a suspect arrested for operating a vehicle while intoxicated.
