## **Synopsis of House Committee Amendments\***

### **Sub. S.B. 33**

132nd General Assembly  
(H. Criminal Justice)

Permits a state highway patrol trooper to administer oaths and acknowledge criminal and juvenile court documents in matters related to the trooper's official duties after completing a course of in-service training approved by the Director of Public Safety.

Provides that when an offender fails to comply with the terms and conditions of intervention in lieu of conviction (ILC), a court may continue the offender on ILC, continue the offender on ILC with additional terms, conditions, and sanctions, or enter a finding of guilty and impose an appropriate sanction.
