## CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Lance Corporal Christopher J. Dyer USMC, Lima Co, 3/25 Marines Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>	The northbound and southbound lanes of Interstate Route 75, from mile marker 13 to mile marker 15, in Hamilton County.
