CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highways and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Michael J. Aselage Memorial Highway" ¹	A portion of State Route 705, commencing at the intersection with Sawmill Road and proceeding in a southerly and easterly direction to the intersection with Eilerman Road, in Shelby County.
"The American Legion Highway" ²	The eastbound and westbound lanes of State Route 703, between the intersection with State Route 29, in Mercer County, and the intersection with State Route 364, in Auglaize County.
"Private First Class Donald E. Byrum Memorial Highway" ³	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 118, between the intersection with Elroy Ansonia Road and the intersection with Beamsville-Union City Road, in Darke County.
