CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Patrolman Dane L. Rowe Memorial Highway" 1	The portion of road known as State Route 317, running in a northerly and southerly direction, between the intersections of Gerling Boulevard and Wingate Road, in Madison Township, in Franklin County

Patrolman Dane L. Rowe was serving with the Madison Township Police Department on November 4, 1988, when he was struck by a motor vehicle while clearing an accident scene. He died the following day from his injuries.
