Bill: H.B. 350 of the 132nd G.A. **Status:** As Reported by House Transportation and Public Safety

Sponsor: Rep. Craig Local Impact Statement Procedure Required: No

Subject: Designates the Patrolman Dane L. Rowe Memorial Highway

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) will incur about \$350 to \$400 in costs for producing and installing memorial signs for this memorial roadway. Specifically, the bill designates the stretch of State Route 317 in Madison Township within Franklin County as the Patrolman Dane L. Rowe Memorial Highway.

If a memorial highway is to be located outside of a municipality, ODOT produces and installs the signs. According to ODOT, the cost of producing and installing a set of signs for memorial highways and bridges is approximately \$350 to \$400, including materials and labor. Two markers are usually installed, one in each direction at each location. Once a set of signs is installed, there are typically no maintenance costs unless the signs are damaged. Signs usually need to be replaced every 12 to 15 years.
