### H.B. 431

#### 132nd General Assembly (As Introduced)

**Reps.** Hughes, Green, Blessing, Retherford, West, Sprague, Boccieri, Hill, Riedel, Romanchuk

#### CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Officer Tommy Hayes Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>	The portion of I-71, running in a northerly and southerly direction, between the intersection of I-71 and State Route 161 and the intersection of I-71 and Morse Road, in Franklin County.

#### COMMENT

Columbus Police Officer Tommy Hayes was shot in the back and paralyzed on December 18, 1979, when attempting to make an arrest. He eventually died from his injuries on January 20, 2011.
