## Fiscal Note & Local Impact Statement

**Bill:** H.B. 477 of the 132nd G.A. **Status:** As Introduced

Sponsor: Rep. Koehler Local Impact Statement Procedure Required: No

**Subject:** Eliminates various obsolete, expired, or inactive education provisions and programs; performance

management section of Ohio Department of Education website

The bill may increase the information technology expenditures of the Department of Education (ODE) to modify its website to prominently display certain metrics regarding the academic and financial performance of each school district. Current law requires these metrics to be displayed on a performance management section of ODE's website. ODE posts this information under the "Financial Data" section of each district's report card.

All other provisions of the bill appear to have no direct fiscal effect on the state or political subdivisions. In general, the bill repeals and makes conforming changes to sections of the Revised Code to eliminate various obsolete, expired, or inactive provisions and programs related to ODE and the operation of primary and secondary schools.
