## Fiscal Note & Local Impact Statement

**Subject:** Designates the Richland County Veterans Memorial Highway

---

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) will incur about \$350 to \$400 in costs for producing and installing a set of memorial signs for this memorial highway. Specifically, the bill designates the stretch of I-71 between where it intersects with State Route 39 and State Route 13 within Richland County as the Richland County Veterans Memorial Highway. When a portion of an interstate is designated as a memorial highway, ODOT produces and installs the signs. Two markers are usually installed, one in each direction at each location. Once a set of signs is installed, there are typically no maintenance costs unless the signs are damaged. Signs usually need to be replaced every 12 to 15 years.
