## **Fiscal Note & Local Impact Statement**

Bill: H.B. 275 of the 132nd G.A.

Subject: Designates the Lance Corporal Michael Stangelo, USMC, Memorial Bridge

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) will incur about \$350 to \$400 in cost for producing memorial signs for this memorial bridge and the city of Canal Fulton will incur a small cost for installing them. Specifically, the bill designates the bridge spanning the Tuscarawas River on State Route 93 in the city of Canal Fulton within Stark County as the Lance Corporal Michael Stangelo, USMC, Memorial Bridge.

If a memorial marker is to be located within the boundaries of a municipality, ODOT produces the signs and may request reimbursement from the municipality for the cost. ODOT, however, does not currently seek this reimbursement. The signs are installed by municipal workers, though, resulting in minimal costs for the municipality where the memorial marker is to be located. Two markers are usually installed, one in each direction at each location. Once a set of signs is installed, there are typically no maintenance costs unless the signs are damaged. Signs usually need to be replaced every 12 to 15 years.

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
