## CONTENT AND OPERATION

## "Stop Bullying" license plate

The bill creates the following license plate: ${ }^{1}$

| Special License Plate | Stop Bullying license plate, which must display an <br> appropriate logo and words selected by the Attorney <br> General that are approved by the Registrar of Motor <br> Vehicles. |
| :--- | :--- |
| Recipients | Available to all applicants. |
| Eligible Vehicles | Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, <br> recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the <br> Registrar. |
| Contribution, Additional BMV <br> Fee, and Use of Contribution | $\$ 25$ required contribution. <br> $\$ 10$ additional administrative BMV fee. |
|  | Contributions must be deposited in the Stop Bullying <br> License Plate Contribution Fund, which is created by the <br> bill. The Attorney General or the Attorney General's <br> designee must use the money in the Fund to issue grants <br> to nonprofit organizations, schools, and school districts that <br> provide bullying prevention training programs or <br> educational opportunities. The Attorney General is required <br> to approve the nonprofit organizations, schools, and school |

[^0]|  | districts that will receive grants and the amounts paid to <br> each nonprofit organization. |
| :--- | :--- |
| Requirements for Issuance | (1) Submission of an application; |
|  | (2) Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, <br> contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved <br> license plate fee if necessary; and |
|  | (3) Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor <br> vehicle registration. |
| Combined with Special <br> Reserved License Plate | May be combined with a special reserved license plate <br> provided in current law. |
| Applicability of License Plate <br> Termination Procedures | Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard <br> license plates apply. |
