Synopsis of House Committee Amendments*

Sub. S.B. 20132nd General Assembly (H. Criminal Justice)

Modifies the specification to require an additional prison term of six years for an offender who is convicted of felonious assault involving physical harm and a specification charging that the victim suffered permanent disabling harm and was less than ten years old at the time of the offense.

Specifies that, if the offender is convicted of the specification described above, the offender must serve the six-year mandatory prison term consecutively to and prior to any prison term imposed for the underlying felonious assault.

Subject to any limitation in existing law, allows any other prison term previously or subsequently imposed to be served concurrently with, or consecutively to, the mandatory prison term, but prohibits imposing any other specifications for the same underlying offense.

Specifies that the court must not impose any other additional prison term relative to the same offense if the court imposes the mandatory prison term based on the specification for causing permanent disabling harm.

Specifies that the mandatory prison term of six years cannot be imposed if the offender is convicted of another specification relative to the same offense.
